












DETAILED ITINERARY

Each room is equipped with complimentary high-speed Wi-Fi, a mini refrigerator, microwave, coffee maker, flat-screen TV, and air conditioning.




Fitness Center

A business center with internet access and meeting rooms are available for corporate travelers.





Day 6. Wildlife Tour & Hot Springs


