

## DAY 1-2 Tumbili Lodge (Arusha)


Boutique lodge with views of Mount Meru.

#### **Highlights:**


Elephants, baobab trees, lions, and wildlife concentrated around the Tarangire River and Mkungunero Waterhole.

#### Wildlife:


Elephants, Maasai giraffes, lions, leopards, and buffalo.






