

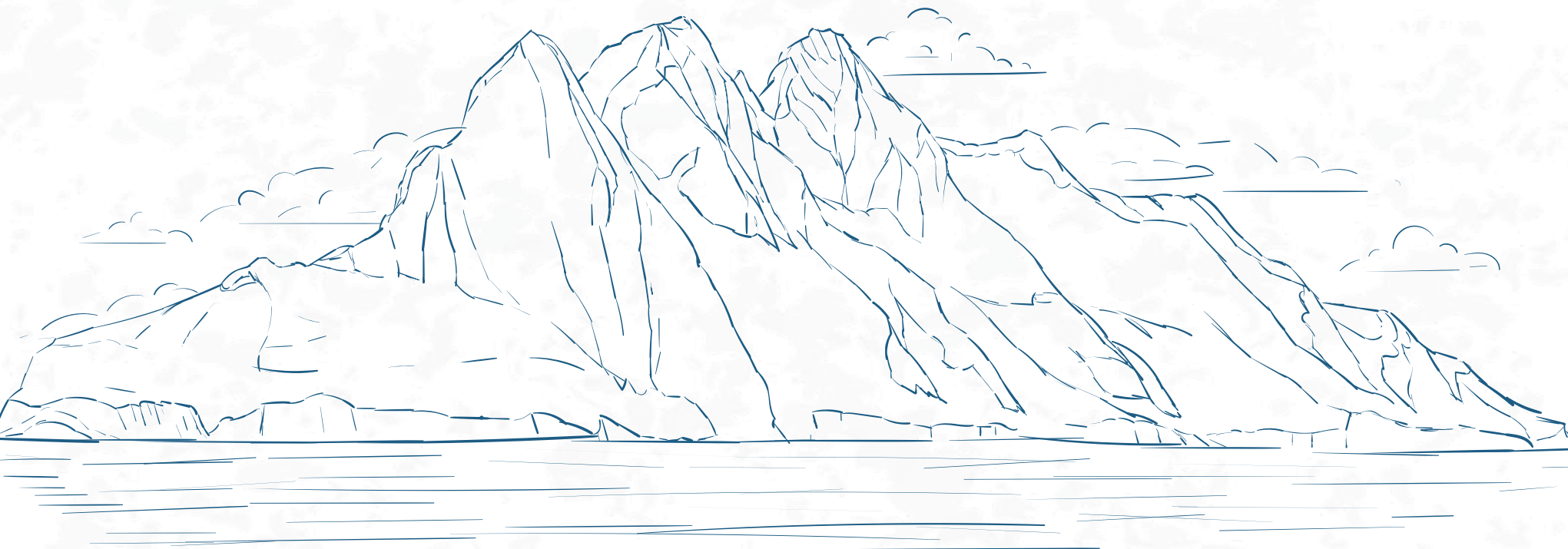

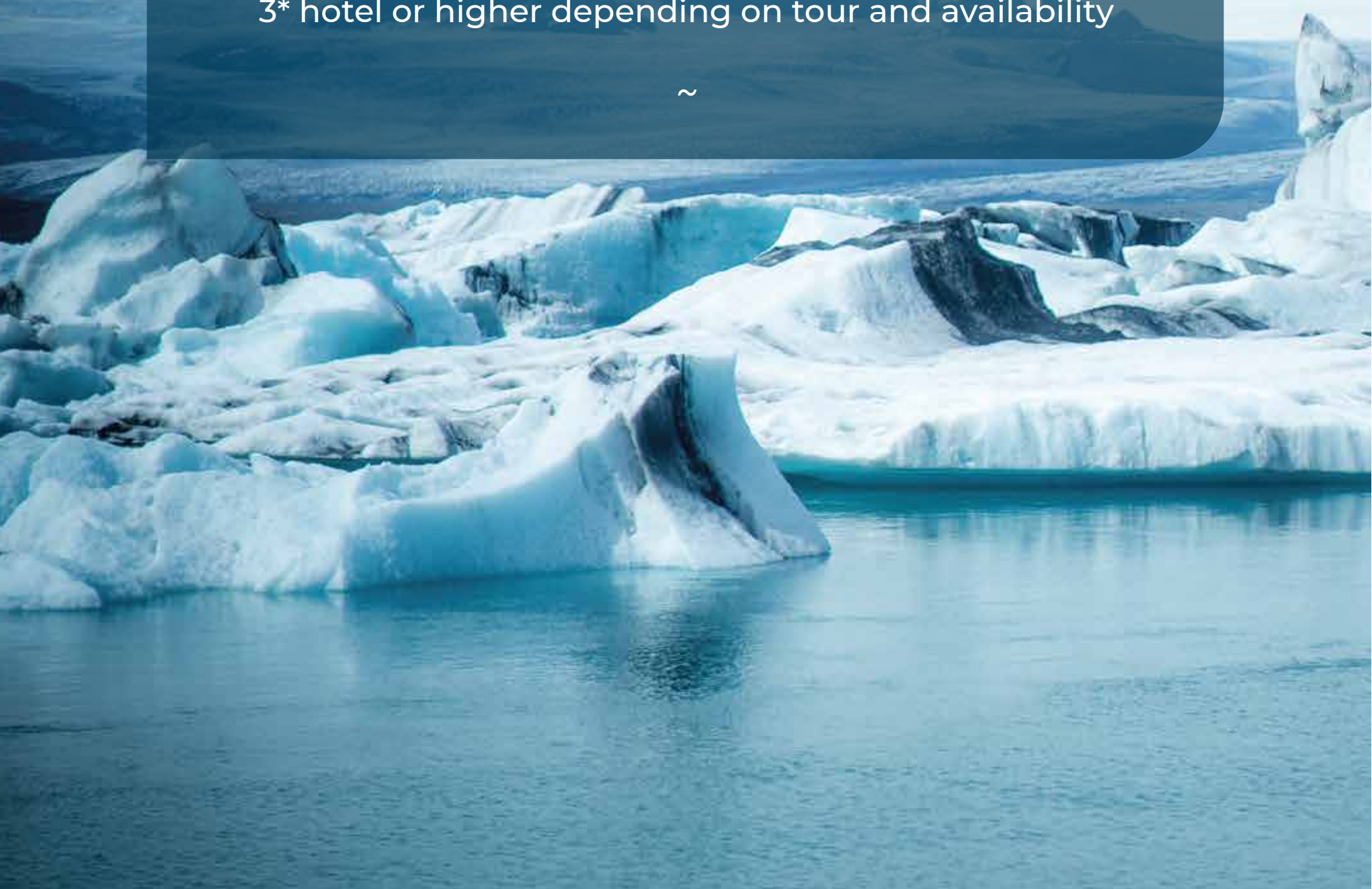

Important Details

Customization:

Every tour is fully customizable.

Add-on:

A photo package can be added to each tour.

Weather:

Itinerary may change due to weather conditions.

Northern Lights:

A Northern Lights hunt is automatically included in every tour during the winter season (September to April).

Summer bookings:

We recommend booking at least 2–3 months in advance to ensure hotel availability (June to September).

Meals:

Breakfast is included with all hotel stays (lunch and dinner are not included unless otherwise specified).

Transport:

All tours include private 4x4 transportation with driver-guide.

Safety note:

Activities such as glacier hikes and boat tours are operated with certified local guides for your safety.

Booking conditions:

A non-refundable deposit of 30% of the total price is required to confirm the booking. The remaining balance must be paid 30 days before the tour start date. For last-minute bookings made less than 30 days before the tour, payment terms can be arranged upon consultation.

DAY 1

The Golden Circle

Pingvellir → Geysir → Gullfoss

Your Icelandic adventure begins with a journey through the country's most famous route – the Golden Circle. Walk between continents at Pingvellir National Park, marvel at the erupting Geysir, and feel the power of Gullfoss waterfall, one of Iceland's most spectacular natural wonders.

Practical details:

- Pick-up from your accommodation in Reykjavík (hotel not included in the tour price)
- Airport pick-up available upon prior arrangement, depending on flight arrival time
- Bring warm, windproof and waterproof clothing – Icelandic weather can change quickly
- Overnight stay: Hotel South Coast * (breakfast included)



DAY 2

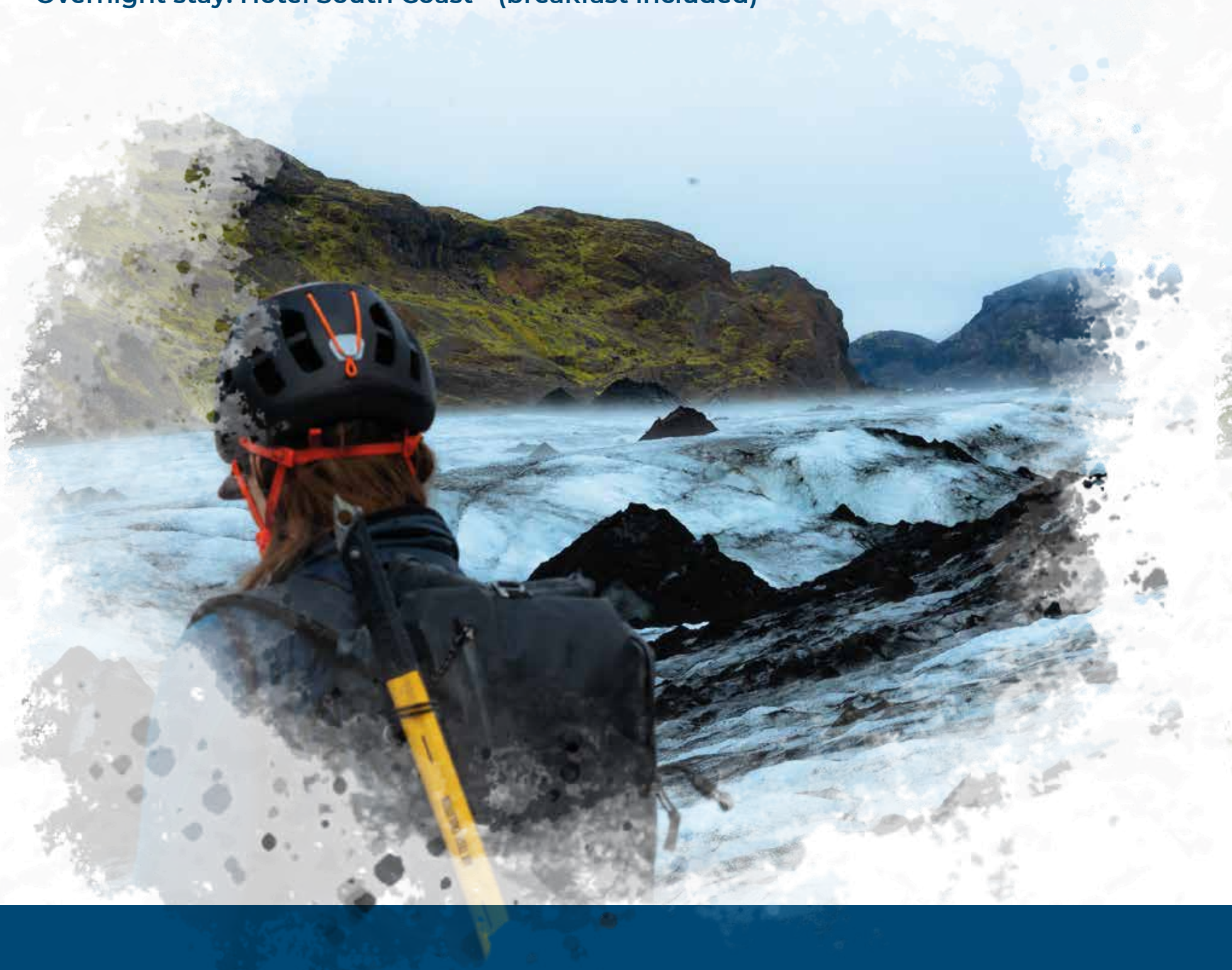
South Coast

Skógafoss → Reynisfjara → Sólheimajökull Glacier Hike → Seljalandsfoss

Begin your journey along Iceland's breathtaking South Coast with a visit to Skógafoss, one of the country's most iconic waterfalls, where rainbows often appear in the mist. Continue to the dramatic Reynisfjara black-sand beach, famous for its striking basalt columns and powerful Atlantic waves. Next, take part in a guided Sólheimajökull Glacier Hike led by a certified glacier guide. End your adventure at the enchanting Seljalandsfoss, where you can walk behind the cascading water for a truly unique view.

Practical details:

- Glacier hike includes all safety equipment
- Dress warmly and wear waterproof outerwear and hiking boots
- Overnight stay: Hotel South Coast * (breakfast included)



DAY 3

Snæfellsnes Peninsula

Gerðuberg → Ytri Tunga → Kirkjufell

Explore the incredible Snæfellsnes Peninsula, often called “*Iceland in Miniature*”. Walk among the Gerðuberg basalt cliffs, visit Ytri Tunga Beach where seals often rest on the rocks, and photograph the striking Kirkjufell mountain, one of Iceland’s most iconic sights.

Practical details:

- Light coastal walks; camera recommended.
- Bring warm, waterproof clothing and comfortable shoes.
- Overnight stay: Hotel South Coast * (breakfast included).



DAY 4

West Iceland

Barnafoss → Hraunfossar → Hvammsvík Bath

Spend your day in West Iceland, visiting the twin waterfalls Barnafoss and Hraunfossar, where glacial water flows through lava formations. Relax at Hvammsvík Hot Springs, a natural oceanside spa surrounded by breathtaking views.

Practical details:

- Bring swimsuit and towel.
- Warm, waterproof outerwear recommended.
- Overnight stay at Hotel South Coast * (breakfast included), or if Day 5 is not included, drop-off in Reykjavík accommodation or, if prearranged, at the airport.



DAY 5

Landmannalaugar

(Optional from June to September)

Hjálparfoss → Hnausapollur → Landmannalaugar → Sigöldugljúfur

For guests staying an extra day, explore the colorful rhyolite mountains of Landmannalaugar, one of Iceland's most beautiful highland areas. Visit Hjálparfoss waterfall, admire the turquoise crater lake Hnausapollur, and relax in the natural hot springs of Landmannalaugar before returning through the canyon Sigöldugljúfur.

Practical details:

- Bring swimsuit, towel, and sturdy hiking shoes.
- Drop-off in Reykjavík accommodation or, if prearranged, at the airport.



Included:

- Private 4x4 transportation with driver-guide
- Hotel South Coast* for the entire stay, including breakfast.

- Listed activities (optional ones available on request)

DAY 5

Mývatn

Finish your journey with a rejuvenating soak in Hvammsvík Hot Springs, a natural oceanside spa overlooking the Atlantic, before returning to Reykjavík.

- Drop-off in Reykjavík accommodation or, if prearranged, at the airport.
