

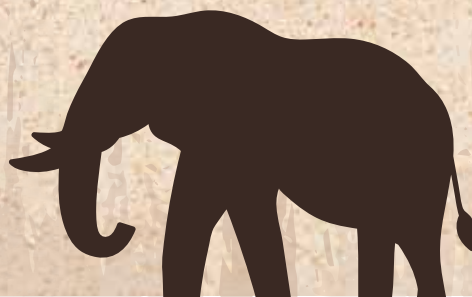
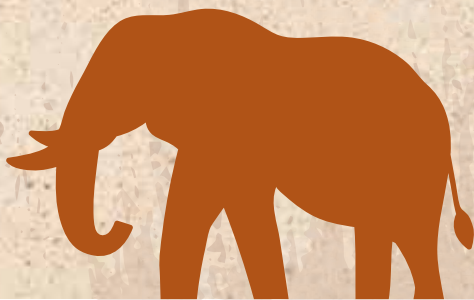
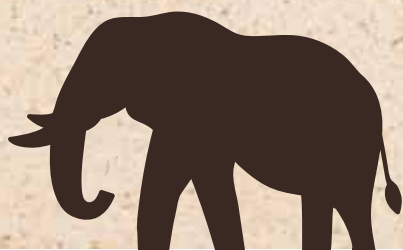

LOW SEASON – DECEMBER, JANUARY, JUNE, JULY

(School holidays might bring more visitors to
the park, potentially affecting the serenity and
exclusivity of your safari.)

SHOULDER SEASON – FEBRUARY TO MAY

(These are the wet seasons. The lush
landscapes, trickier wildlife spotting but
amazing birdwatching opportunities.)

DETAILED ITINERARY

DAY 1

Arrival in Johannesburg

- Airport pickup and transfer to a Safari Guest House in Johannesburg.
- Meet and greet with our team at the Guest House.
- We will have a warm dinner and a good night's rest to recharge after the long flight.



DAY 2

Transfer to Kruger National Park

- After breakfast you will depart for Crocodile Bridge Gate on the South Eastern Border of Kruger National Park.
- Enjoy a scenic 7-hour drive through the picturesque South African countryside.
- Arrive at your Safari Lodge in time to unpack, unwind and witness a breath taking African sunset.
- Savour a delicious dinner paired with some of South Africa's finest wines, setting the tone for an unforgettable Kruger Safari adventure.



DAY 3

Exploring The South Eastern Parts of Kruger

- Begin the day with a pre-dawn coffee or tea and a rusk break.
- Embark on an early morning game drive from Crocodile Bridge Gate to Lower Sabie and Berg en Dal.
- Enjoy this scenic drive through Kruger's stunning landscapes, with opportunities to spot Elephant, Buffalo and Antelope.
- Stop for a hearty brunch at Lower Sabie, while enjoying the breath taking view over the famous Sabie River.
- Return to the lodge via a leisurely game drive, arriving back before the park's closing time.
- Unwind, with a relaxing evening around the campfire, paired with exceptional wine and cuisine.



DAY 4

Elephant Interaction Day

- Savour a leisurely morning at the lodge with a hearty breakfast.
- Depart for an unforgettable Elephant interaction experience, where you'll have the opportunity to touch, feed and walk alongside these gentle giants.
- Following the Elephant encounter, explore the small village of Hazyview and discover its local charm.
- Conclude the day with either a sunset game drive, wrapping up an unforgettable day in the African wilderness. After which we will head back to our Lodge where a warm meal will be waiting on us.



DAY 5

Transfer From Crocodile Bridge to Phabeni Gate

- Start the day with a warm welcome and a steaming cup of coffee or tea, accompanied by a selection of sweet and savoury.
- **Please note:** Pack all belongings this morning, as we'll be departing for a new location.
- Embark on an early morning game drive with a scenic drive and opportunities to spot Giraffe, Rhino and lots of Birdlife.
- We'll stop for lunch at Skukuza, the park's largest rest camp and take in the breath taking view – you'll see why it's a standout.
- After lunch, we'll continue North through the park, making our way to Satara and Letaba at the Central region of the park, where we will spend the next 3 nights of our final leg of the safari.
- End the day with a toast to the African wilderness with a glass of Amarula as the stars begin to twinkle above.



DAY 6

Exploring Satara and Letaba

- Begin the day with a pre-dawn coffee, tea and rusk break.
- Embark on an early morning game drive exploring the areas around Satara.
- Enjoy this scenic drive through Kruger's stunning landscapes, with opportunities to spot some of Africa's big cats. Lions, Cheetahs and Leopard are often seen in this area.
- Stop for a hearty lunch in Central Kruger, while enjoying the African wilderness.
- After lunch we will head north towards Letaba before we unwind, with a relaxing evening around the campfire, paired with exceptional wine and cuisine.



DAY 7

Exploring Central Kruger

- Begin the day with a pre-dawn coffee, tea and rusk break, before embarking on an exciting adventure.
- Explore Central Kruger region, focusing on the Letaba area, in search of the elusive Big 5.
- Enjoy a delightful brunch amidst game viewing, before we attend to our final activity of the trip.
- A major highlight of our journey will be a visit to the Letaba Elephant Hall, where you'll uncover the fascinating history of the "magnificent seven" elephants that once roamed these trails.
- After another beautiful day in Africa, we gather around for a warm dinner, paired with exceptional wine, and reflect on the unforgettable experiences and memories made during our safari in Kruger.



DAY 8

Departure To Johannesburg

- Depart the lodge early and begin the journey back to Johannesburg.
- Enjoy a quick brunch on the road.
- Arrive in Johannesburg with plenty of time to spare, approximately 3 hours prior to your international departure, marking the end of our unforgettable safari adventure.
